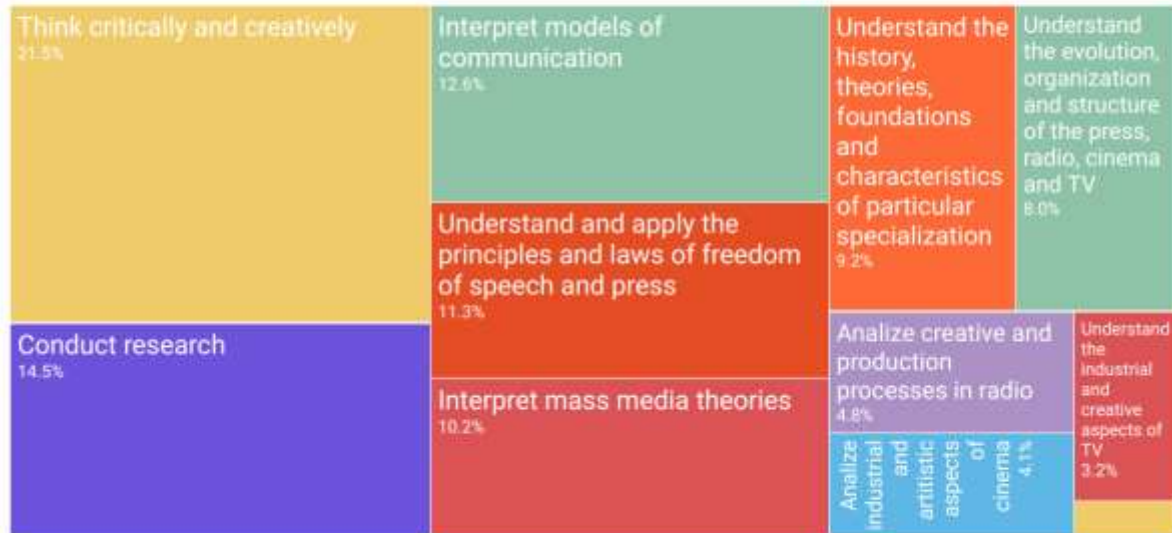

# Knowledge acquired by the alumni

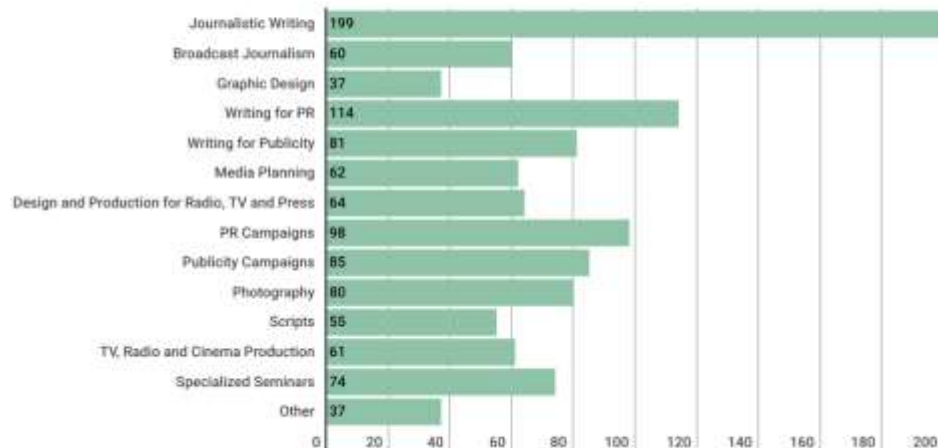

## Practical courses

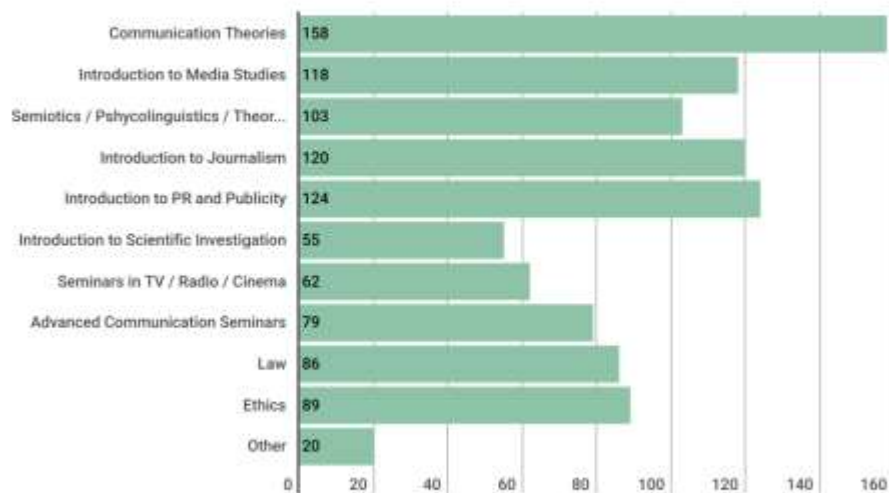

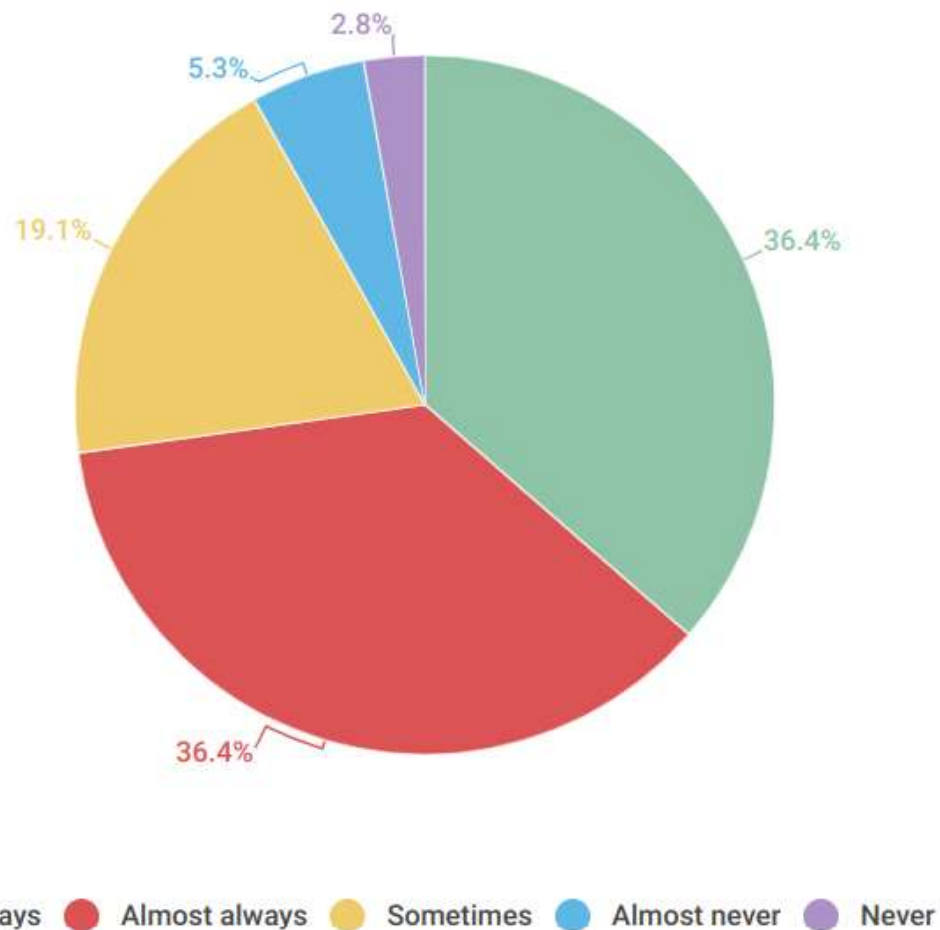
A total of 298 participants made 1,010 selections in this question.

## Recommendations from the alumni (practical training)

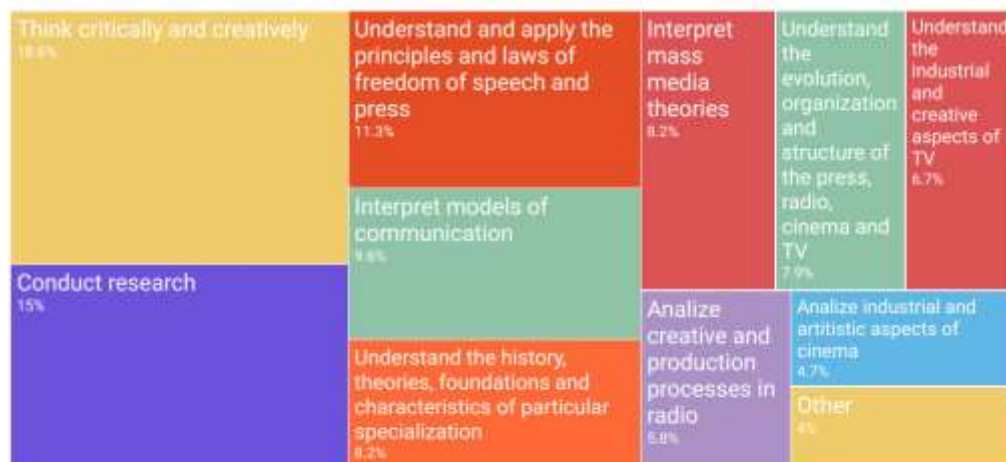

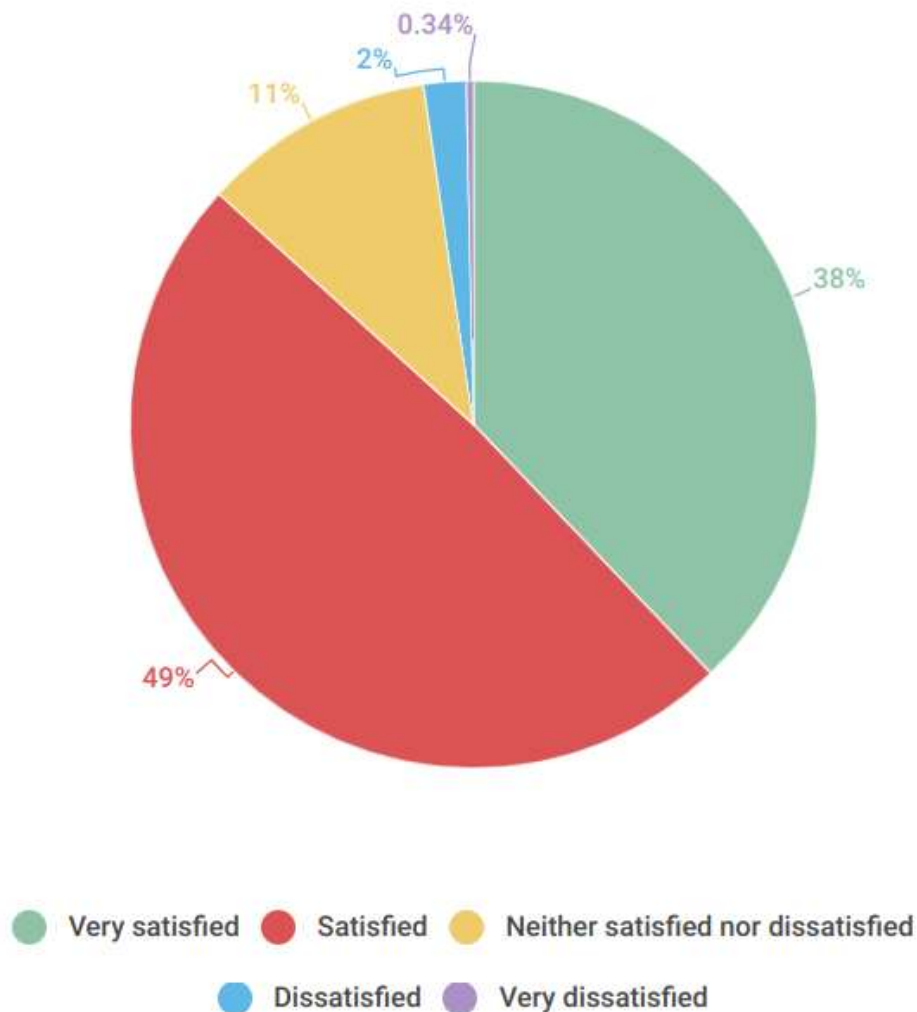


A total of 261 participants made 927 selections in this question.

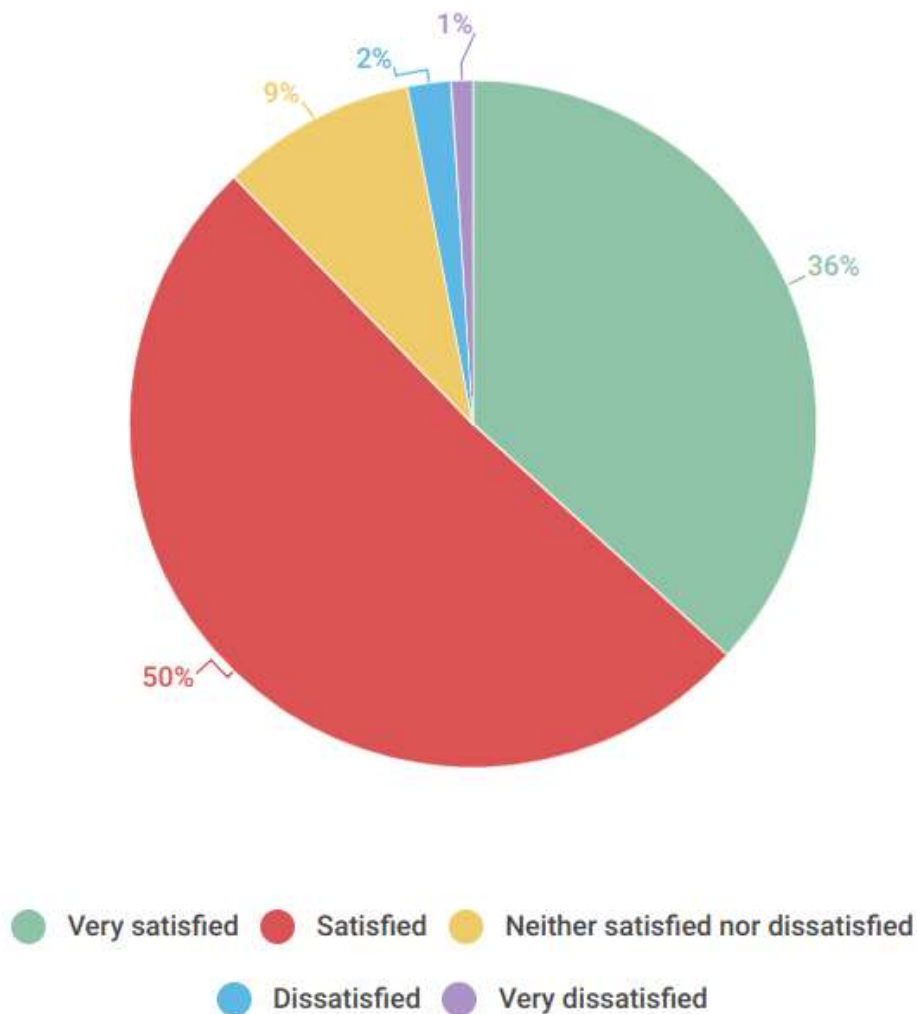


A total of 281 participated in this question.
